

## **IPOA RECEIVES FORENSIC EQUIPMENT DONATION**

Since inception in 2012, the Independent Policing Oversight Authority has progressively made milestone achievements in its effort to professionalize the National Police Service. This has been done through concentrated capacity building and tooling its functional Directorates.

Apart from the National Treasury budget allocation, this has also been made possible through the support of Development Partners who have continued to support the Authority through training opportunities and provision of technical tools and equipment to enable professional investigations, inspections and monitoring of police activities.
